Earthquakes, erupting volcanoes, polluted oceans, global warming, disease and drought are just some of the environmental disasters facing the earth. It looks the children are the only ones who can save the universe.

The young actors with the Teater Tanah Air troupe have travelled all the way from Jakarta to paint this bleak picture of the decline of the natural world. But it turns out that the basic humanity of the children – which makes no distinction based on nationality, tribe, social class, religion, or ideology (thus the title ZERO) – has the power to heal and bring peace to the people, plants and animals. And they can deal with child aliens from outer space too! This story is told through percussive singing and dancing, and the rainbow colours of the actors' costumes.
